On Tuesday, October 27, 2020, Thomas Charles Schalk passed away at his home in Houston, Texas. Thomas served as a Captain in the US Army, completing two tours of duty in Vietnam from 1968-1969 and 1971-1972. During his first tour, he served as a Forward Artillery Observer with the 92nd Field Artillery Regiment "Brave Cannons" attached to the 5th Special Forces Group. After completing his first tour, Tom completed Army flight school and earned his Army Aviator Badge. A memorial service is planned for Friday, November 20 at 11:00 AM at the Cypress-Fairbanks Funeral Home.
